CT-ALIVE, is a Connecticut non-profit corporation, which is tax-exempt under Section 501 (c) (3) of the IRS Tax Code. It was established in May of 2002 by a group of survivors of homicide who wanted to help other survivors heal after the horrific trauma they had experienced.

CT-ALIVE offers programs that help victims and their families break permanently out of the cycle of violence and reclaim their lives. The *Never Going Back to Abuse Project* provides the critical "next step" for women to move beyond survivor, to "thriver."

CT-ALIVE supports FREE motivational workshops, monthly follow-up groups and annual weekend retreats to restore and re-energize women who have experienced abuse, as well as coaching sessions to help them accomplish their goals.

Through this project, women uncover their hidden talents, awaken their creative potential and create a new, non-violent future for themselves and their children. These women are less likely to return to an abusive relationship and/or suffer the long-term physical/psychological consequences of the abuse.
